Hello Resident Family Members,

Despite the staff working very hard and being diligent, I regret to inform you that the COVID-19 Outbreak has been extended until at least the end of the day May 9, 2022. Therefore visiting on site is not possible until Island Health Public Health and the Medical Health Officer – Dr. Mike Benusic give VCCC clearance.

The residents are managing very well despite the cases of COVID-19. Those that have symptoms seem to have comparatively mild symptoms.

Enhanced cleaning continues to be underway and isolation practices continue with those that have a positive diagnosis. Personal Protective Equipment is used habitually by staff. It is common to see staff sanitizing residents' hands as they come and go from the Main floor and Dining Room. We also continue to limit the number of residents using the elevator at any one time.

We are trying to provide residents with as much stimulation and activity as possible and healthy residents continue to dine in the Dining room. Some resident family members are dropping off 'goodies' for their loved ones and we of course welcome this with some advance notice.
