The Victoria Chinatown Care Centre (“VCCC”) is an accredited long-term care facility located in Victoria, BC. We are a non-profit organization overseen by a volunteer Board of Directors with a reputation for high quality care and leading practices. VCCC is an affiliate organization to Island Health’s Residential Care Program and receives public funding from Island Health. VCCC operates 31 residential complex care beds in a culturally-sensitive environment, and provides services including an adult day program and a community bathing program (temporarily suspended due to COVID-19).

### **JOB DUTIES:**

- Provides nursing services and interventions to residents and clients with stable and predictable health status, based on assessment and care planning procedures, and within the LPN scope of practice
- Responsible for Nursing observation and documentation of all residents, updating and changing of care plan to reflect changing resident needs, provides nursing input to care conferences
- Administers medications by all prescribed routes (except direct IV) Monitors, stores and documents medication outcomes in accordance with accepted standards and regulations. Functions as nursing liaison with Physician and Pharmacist regarding medication review, changes to orders and medication protocols
- Performs therapeutic nursing practices, and interventions in accordance with established practice, standards and guidelines. Includes but not limited to: dressings, Oxygen administration, Bowel Care, Alternate feeding approaches, Skin care assessment, and fall’s assessments
- Coordinate health services and provides support in activities of daily living
- Collaborates with RN/RPN’s and Director of Care when resident/client condition is no longer stable and predictable or the care is outside the LPN scope of practice
- Provides safety and health information to individuals and their families, shares work related information with others, demonstrates clinical tasks, proper use of equipment and techniques and provides guidance to others
- Assigns and monitors tasks related to resident/client care and determines priorities

- Graduation from a recognized School of Practical Nursing
- Minimum one (1) year experience in Geriatric Nursing
- First aid certificate (Level One – WCB) required
- Registration with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM)
